

Scoring & Ranking:

First, project must meet the ARPA guidelines. Then, each project will be scored on a scale of 0-10 based on criteria below to establish a ranking of projects for recommendation to the Board of Selectmen.

Criteria:

- **Cost**

0 - \$300,000 +
1 - \$200,000 - \$300,000
2 - \$150,001-\$200,000
3 - \$100,001 - \$150,000
4 - \$75,001 - \$100,000
5 - \$50,001 - \$75,000
6 - \$25,001 - \$50,000
7 - \$10,001- \$25,000
8 - \$5,001 - \$10,000
9 - \$1,001 - \$5,000
10 - \$0 - \$1,000

- **Urgency**

- 0= not at all urgent, 10= immediate need

- **Negative economic impact due to COVID**

- Does the project address the negative economic impacts of COVID-19 for individuals or businesses?

- **Community Resource Impact**

- Does the project improve a physical or electronic resource used by many community members? How much value does it/would it add to the community?

- **Public health impact**

- Does the project address the public health of the community? Will it help with public messaging, disease mitigation or prevention, or emergency preparedness?

- **Infrastructure rank**

- Does the project address a critical infrastructure need such as roads, sidewalks, water, sanitation, broadband?

- **Current or future budget offset**

- Will the project help to reduce cost to taxpayers? Would this need to be funded in future budgets if not funded now? How soon?
